Performance Measures


1. Crime Severity Index

EPS's Crime Severity Index (EPS calculations)

- City-council target: 86 or below (8.0 point reduction from 2013 levels)
- Status: 108.6 (5.9% below Q1 2016) (off-target)


EPS Crime Severity Index

2-4. Crime Levels

- Target: reduction from 2016 levels
- Status: Violent Crime Indicators (+1.7%) (near target)
- Property Crime Indicators (-2.5%) (on-target)
- Social Disorder occurrences (+2.7%) (near target)





5-6. Traffic Safety & Enforcement

- DOTON POLICY ARRIVE
- Target: 4% reduction in traffic fatalities and major injuries from 2010-2014 average
- Status: +1.6% in major injuries / -37.5% in fatalities (on-target)






7-8. Speeding / Distracted Driving Enforcement

AND LOCAL POLICY AND LO

- Target: increase from 2016 levels
- Status: +7.0% in speeding tickets issued (on-target)
- +57.4% in distracted driving tickets issued (on-target)



9. Weighted Clearance Rates


Target: 43% or higher

Status: 45.4% (on-target)

12. Priority 1 Response Time Performance

- Target: 80% or higher
- Status: 76.3% of events met the target (near target)
- Q2 reporting will include performance for other priority levels (2-5)

14. 911 Operator Answer Performance

- DOTON POLICE ARRIVO
- Target: 911 calls answered within 15 seconds, 95% of the time
- Status: 99.8% (on-target)
 - (fewer than 2 calls per 1,000 do not meet standard)


EPS: 911 Operator Answer Performance


% of 911 calls answered in 5, 10, 15 seconds



18-19. Recruitment

- antonios Policy at a race
- Target: increase in EPS applicants / +5% in female applicants
- Total EPS applicants: 16.1% below annual target (off-target)
- Female applicants: 1.7% above annual target (on-target)







Strategic Initiatives

5. Warrant Project - off-target

- Completed: EPROS Offender Management Report (OMR) enhancements, outcome reporting in Cognos BI system
- Delayed: Business requirements for Phase 2 IT solution
- +1.6% persons with criminal warrants (from 2016 year-end levels)
 - Outstanding warrants driven by rising intake (due to higher crime levels in last two years)

7. Collision Reporting Centres (CRC's) – off target



- Goals: reduce police attendance for less serious traffic collisions and contract out processing of collision reports.
- A Negotiation Request for Proposal (NRFP) has been drafted by EPS. Further review by Legal and COE required. NRFP will eventually be put out by COE for vendor marketplace bidding.
- The proposal reflects input from Alberta Transportation on various criteria the proposal will need to satisfy for provincial reporting standards.

10. Proactive Recruiting & Mentoring - on-target



Goals:

- Mentor 30 prospective female and/or minority applicants through the application process. 50% or more complete stage 1-8 application by end of year
- Increase recruitment events at post-secondary schools

Status:

19 applicants currently being mentored. Demographic information is as follows:

	Gender		Minority	
	Male	Female	Yes	No
Applicants	32%	68%	72%	28%

- As the Recruit Mentorship Program is new, only 16% of these applicants have submitted their stage 1-8 application
- 21 post-secondary campus recruiting events are up 250%
