INTRODUCTION:

This monthly information report provides an update to the Edmonton Police Commission on the Edmonton Police Service's authorized full time equivalencies versus actual full time equivalencies for the time period of 2017 January 01 to 2017 March 31 inclusive.

COMMENTS/DISCUSSION:

As of 2017 March 31, we were over authorized strength by 27.23 sworn member FTE's. We were under authorized strength by 32.48 civilian members FTE's for a total of 5.25 FTE's under authorized strength.

Included in the above sworn numbers are the 59 recruits and pre-hires that have not gone out onto the street.
