

- Unanimously passed by Edmonton City Council, September 2015
- 1<sup>st</sup> major city in Canada to officially approve VISION ZERO
- **Goal:** eliminate fatalities and serious injuries on our roads



## Collision Synopsis Edmonton 2017



Fatal, injury and property damage collisions for 2017 = 23,855

- 27 Fatalities or one every two weeks
- 3,354 Injury collisions, <1 Major inj and >8 Minor inj. per day
  - 3.8 injuries per 1,000
- 20,447 Property damage collisions or 56 per day


In Edmonton for 2017 → \$433,259,446 (only Direct Cost)






# Fatalities and Major Injuries trend




#### Fatalities + Major Injuries





## Vision Zero Edmonton Fatality and Major Injury Causes (2017)











#### **Collisions in Edmonton 1997-2017**


