#### What is HealthIM?

- Mental Health Screening Program
- Application deployed to smartphones
- Provides decision support for mental health calls
- Summarizes prior interactions related to mental health
- Facilitates improved safety for all parties (known triggers, de-escalation advice, other contextual information)
- Builds and transmits detailed records to receiving hospitals



#### When to use HealthIM

- During all calls where the individual's mental health is a factor
- Not only for involuntary apprehensions
  - (Form 10)
- Apprehension on authority of a mental health order
  - (Form 1 or Form 8)
- Mobile format allows for increased versatility
- Used only when safe and reasonable to do so



#### **Benefits of HealthIM**

- Displays a pre-response safety briefing including:
  - triggers, de-escalation advice and known safety risks
- Generates clinically-validated risk scores:
  - supports decision making regarding apprehension
- Provides advanced notice of police arrival to hospitals
  - includes a detailed account of individual's behaviour
- Builds a documented history of efforts and
  - supports provided to individuals in crisis






#### **Patrol Use**


- For use on duty issued mobile devices
- Patrol Member discretion to deploy tool
  - All calls involving an acute MH crisis
  - Suicide attempts, Check for wellness
  - "Forms" (MHA Forms 1, 3, 8, 10, 23)
- Member determination of safety to conduct 4-5 min on-scene risk assessment
