2023 CITIZEN PERCEPTION SURVEY

- Surveys were collected May June 2023
- Canada-wide survey conducted annually by Advanis
- Edmonton results can be compared year over year and to other cities

PAST AND CURRENT CITIZEN PERCEPTION SURVEYS

2016 – 2018 Insight Panel and Online Link

- Invited members of City Insight Panel and posted link to EPS social media and websites
- Self-selection
- Non-random sample
- Under-represented people of colour, young adults, low income households

2021 – 2023 Advanis Police Benchmark Study

- Random selection and invitation to participate
- Weighted based on census data
- Representative of Edmonton population

PARTICIPANTS

- 1,727 Edmonton residents participated in 2023
- 49% identified as women, 3% identified as gender diverse
- 36% were between 18 and 34 years old
- 64% reported a household income of less than \$60,000 annually
- 6% identified as Indigenous and 27% identified as people of colour

Compared to 2022, the percent of citizens who...







Edmonton citizens are less likely to believe police exceed their authority than previous years.




■ Never/Rarely □ Sometimes ■ Always/Almost always/Most of the time

SATISFACTION WITH EPS IS RELATED TO...




PERCEPTIONS OF SAFETY



EPS PRESENCE IN NEIGHBOURHOOD


Net 9% of Edmonton citizens noticed an increased EPS member presences in their neighbourhood.


Volume Breakdown - Outbound
