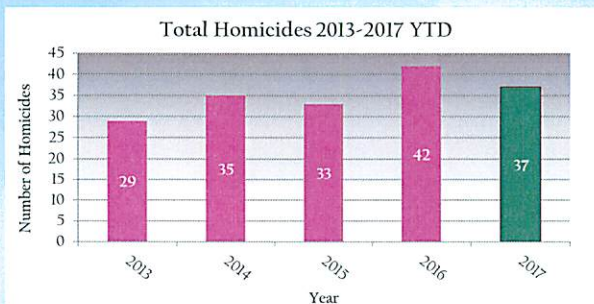

Total Homicides 2013-2017 YTD

- There have been 37 victims of homicide in the City of Edmonton year to date in 2017.
- This is slightly higher than the number of homicides by this time in 2016, which was 42.
- Therefore it is reasonable to suggest that by the end of 2017, the number of homicides will increase by year end.

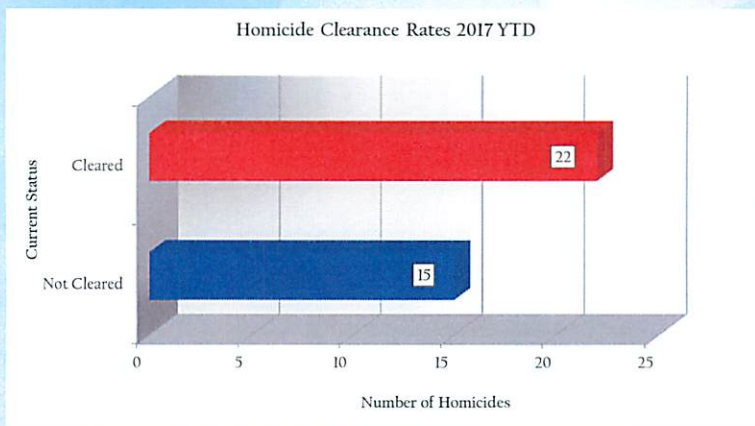

2017 YTD Clearance Rates

- 22 (59%) of the 37 homicides year to date in 2017 have been cleared.

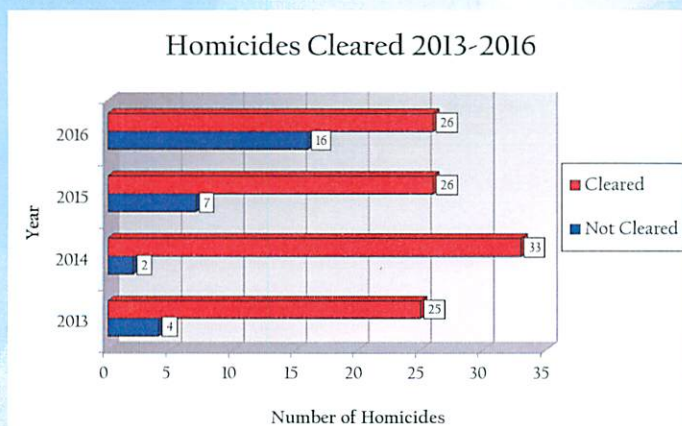

Homicide Clearance Rates 2013-2016

- 62% (26) of the files from 2016 were cleared, 79% (26) from 2015, 94% (33) from 2014 and 86% (25) from 2013.

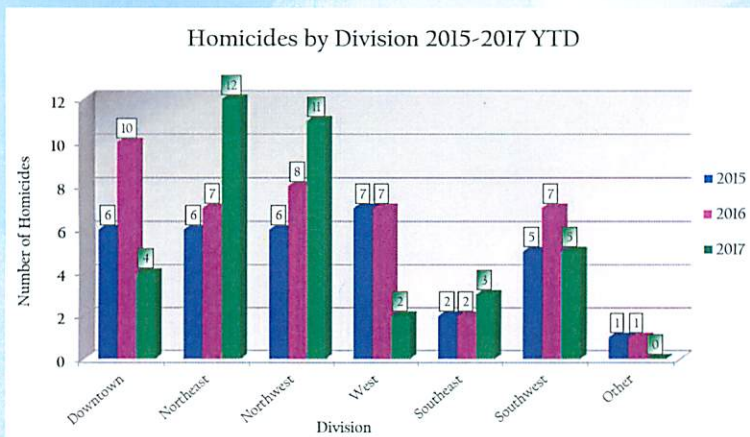

Homicides by Division 2015-2017 YTD

- 62% of the homicides in 2017 occurred in Northwest and Northeast Divisions combined.

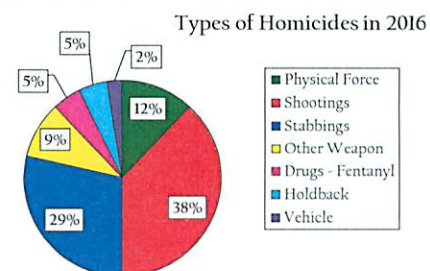
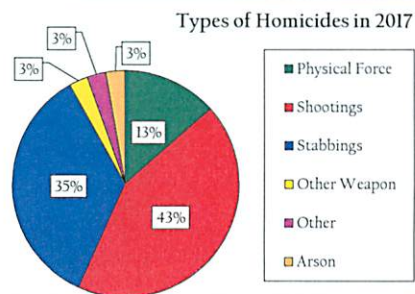

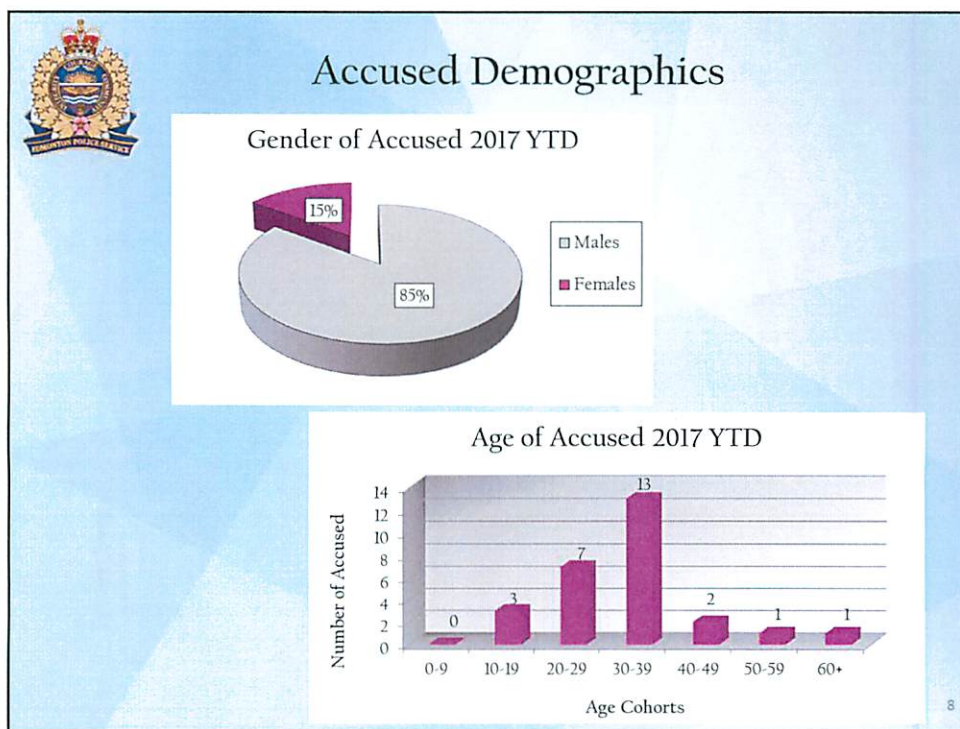
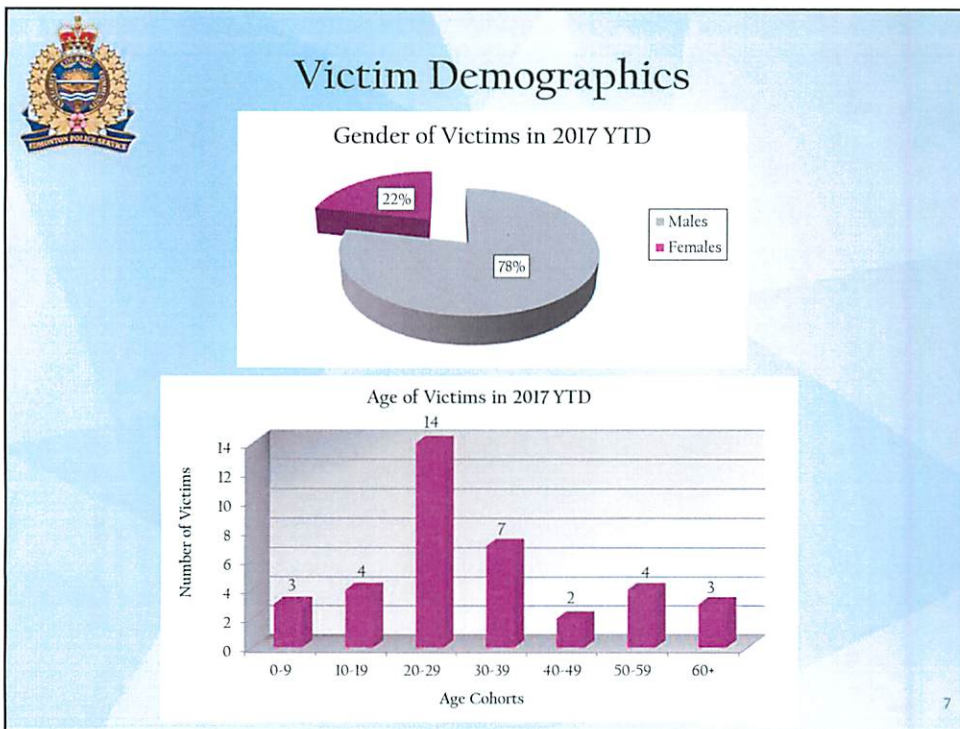


Types of Homicides 2017 YTD & 2016

- Although it may visually seem that shootings and stabbings have increased from 2016 to 2017, the number of shootings stayed the same, and stabbings increased by 1 occurrence (this will likely change by the end of 2017).
- In 2016, there was an increase in the number of shootings by 33% from 12 in 2015 to 16 in 2016.
- In 2016, homicide section had 2 fentanyl related deaths. These were the first 2 incidents such as this where charges were laid.



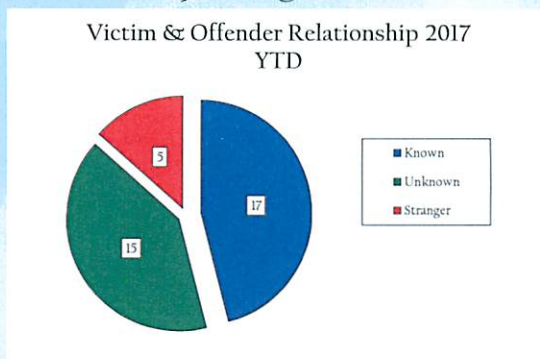

Victim Offender Relationships

- In 2017 almost half of victims, 46%, knew their assailant.
- Year to date, there have been 4 spousal homicides that have been cleared by charges.

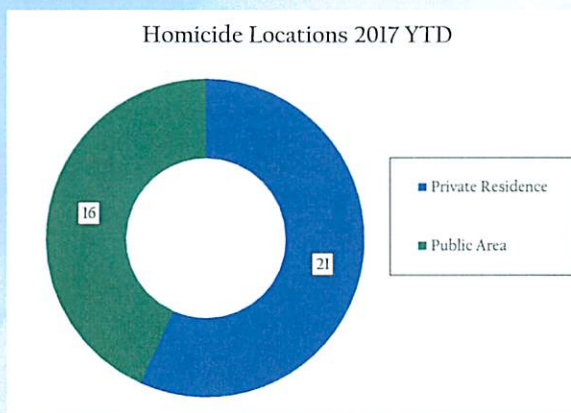
