## Hate Crimes vs Hate Incidents

Hate Crime is a **CRIME:**

VS

Hate Incident is a **NON-CRIMINAL ACTION:**

committed against a person or property that is motivated in whole or in part by hate, bias or prejudice towards an identifiable group based on real or perceived race, national or ethnic origin, language, colour, religion, sex, age, mental or physical disability, sexual orientation, or gender identity or expression, or on any other similar factor.

## Sentencing Provision – other Crimes

Sec 718.2(a)(i) of the Criminal Code – A court that imposes **a sentence shall also take into consideration if there is evidence** that the offence was motivated by bias, prejudice or hate...

- Sought after a conviction of the crime, such as assault, uttering threats, etc at sentencing.

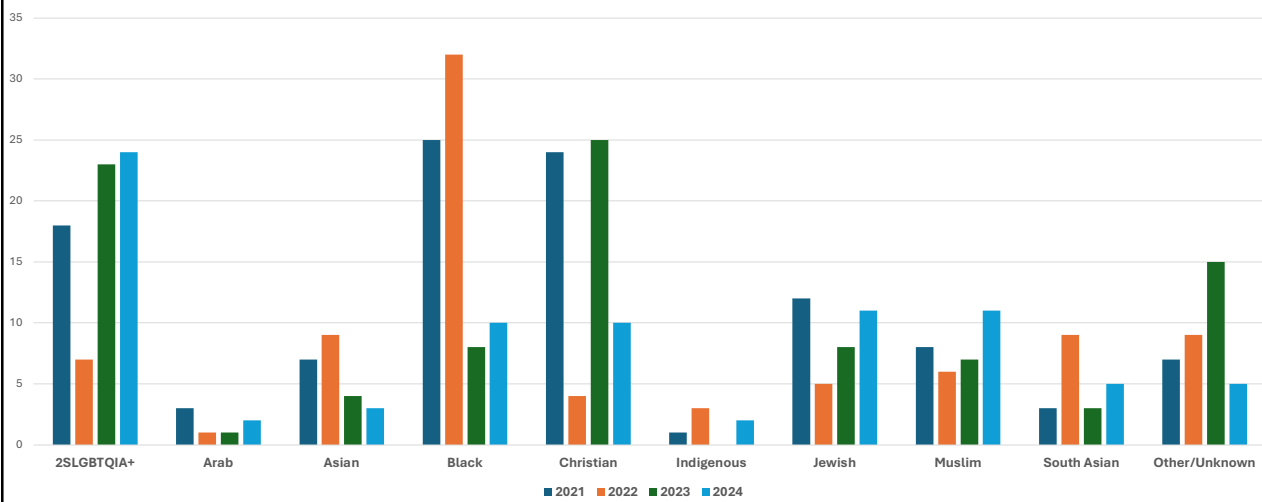
# 15.3% Increase in Hate Incidents from 2023 to 2024



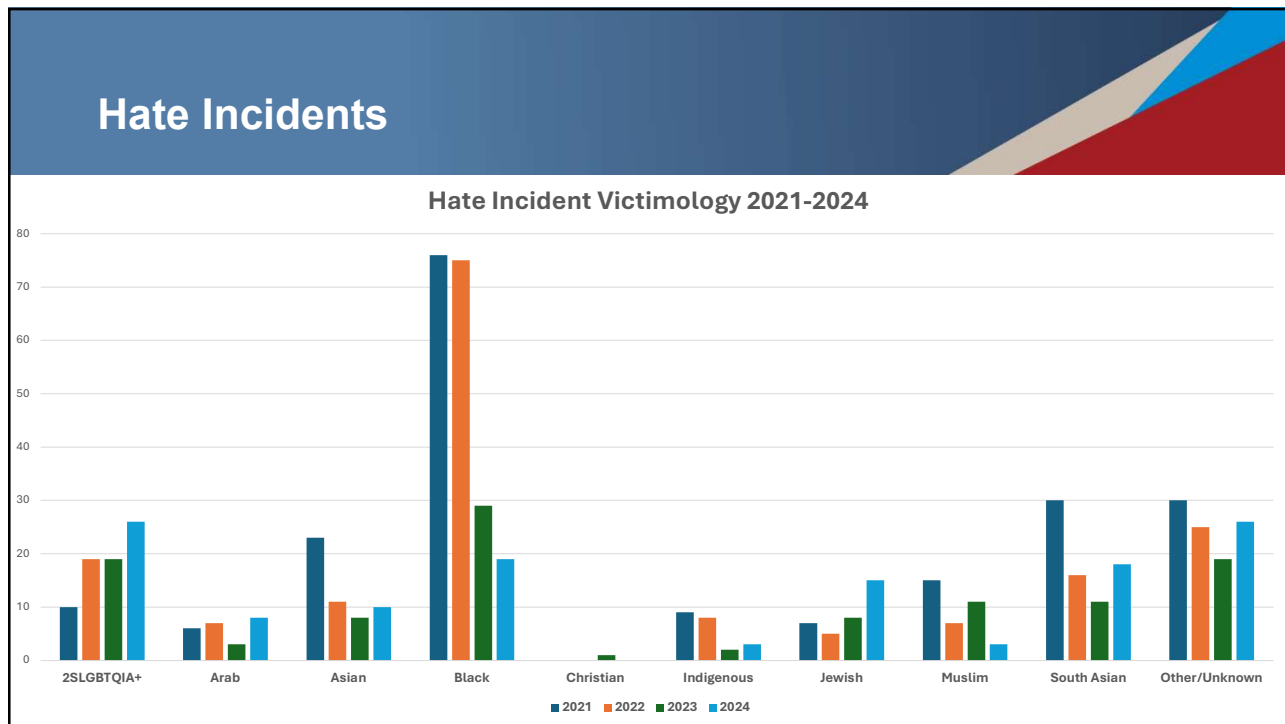
